Dear Parent,

An individual in your child's class has been diagnosed with COVID-19,

The last time the infected person was in the school setting while contagious was ______

- The most common symptoms of COVID infection are cough, fever and shortness of breath;
 muscle aches, sore throat and fatigue are also common
- Symptoms usually develop between 2 to 14 days after last exposure.
- Some infected people never develop symptoms.

You should:

- Monitor your child for symptoms and do temperature checks at least twice daily for the next 14 days.
- If at any point your child's temperature 100.4°F or more consult with your healthcare provider for evaluation.
- Consult with your physician for evaluation and need for testing if your child develops any COVIDlike symptoms whether or not fever occurs.
- As a reminder, always keep your child at home if they are ill for any reason.
